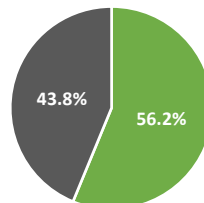

Students Enrollment in Texas Institutions of Higher Education in First Fall Semester Immediately Following High School Graduation



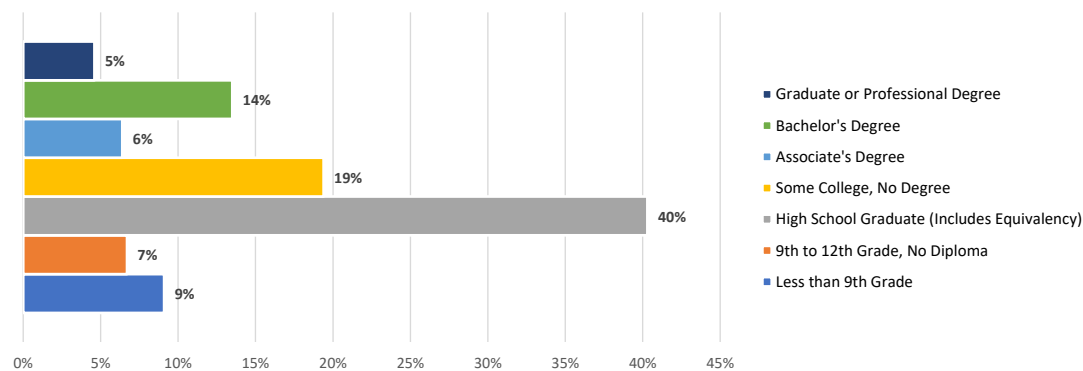

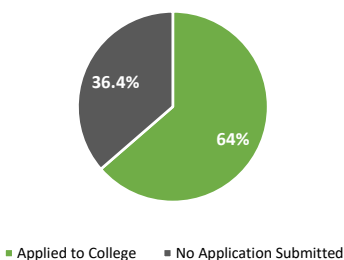

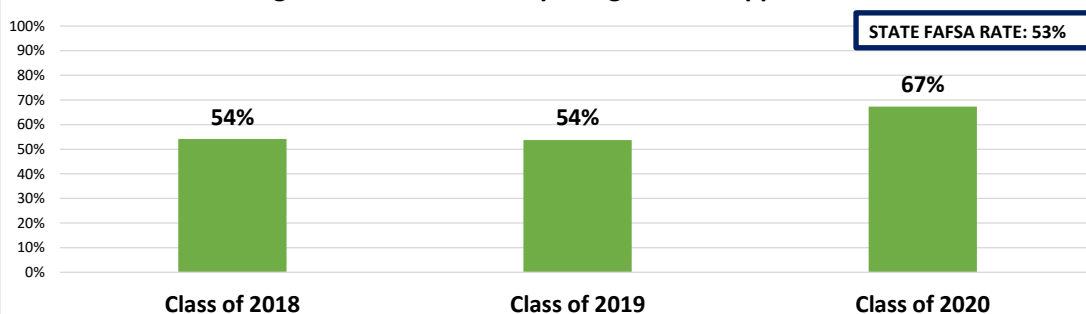
STUDENTS COMPLETING COLLEGE APPLICATIONS - SCHULENBURG ISD
