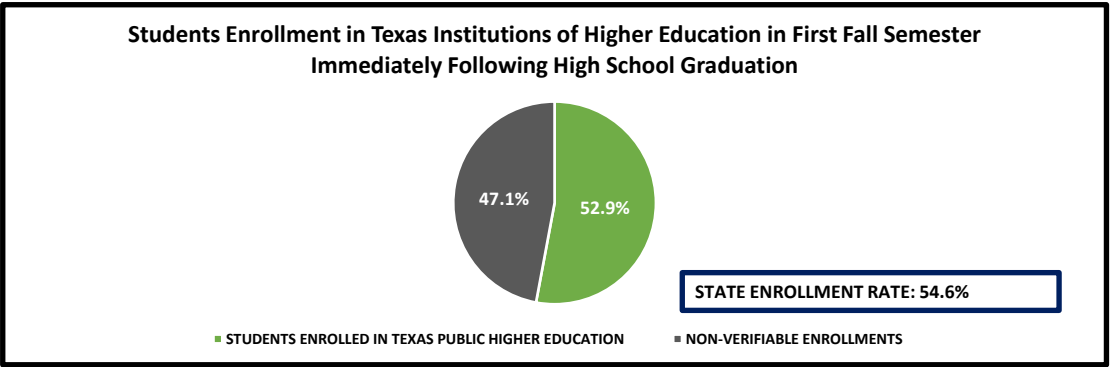

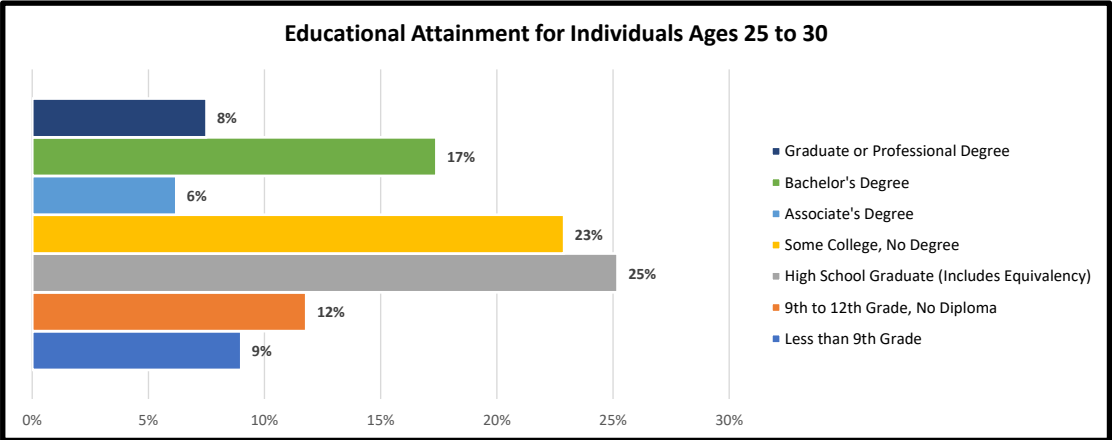

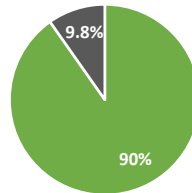

### STUDENTS COMPLETING COLLEGE APPLICATIONS - RIVIERA ISD

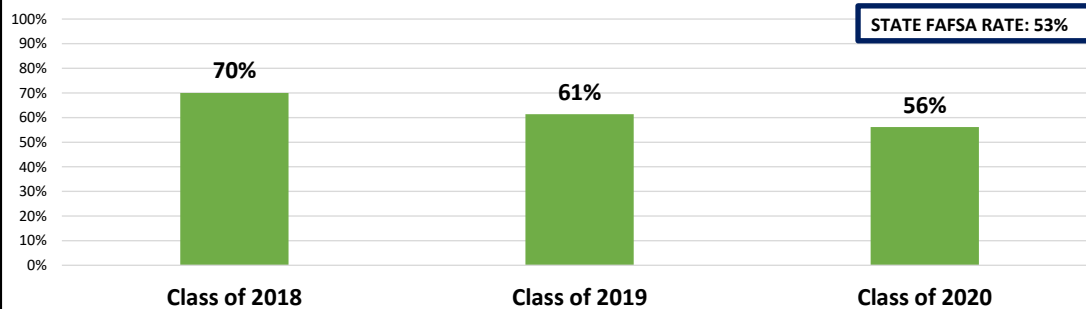
Percent of Students Completing at Least 1
