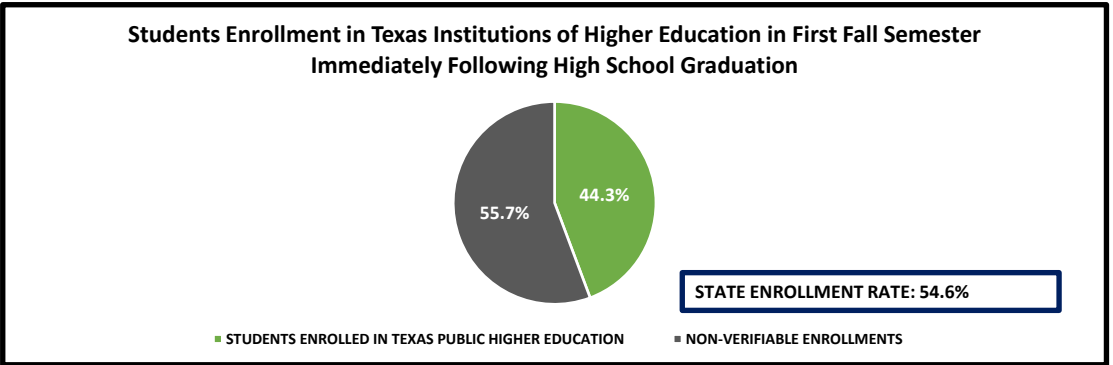

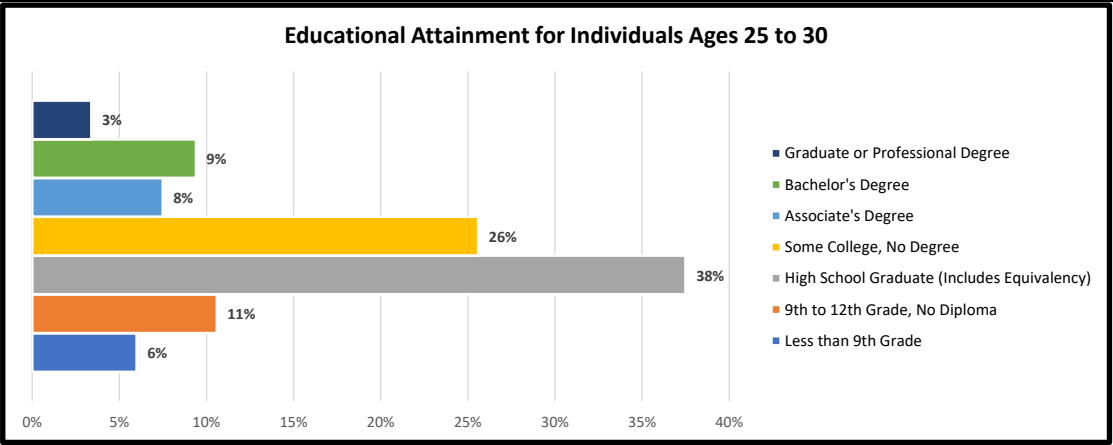

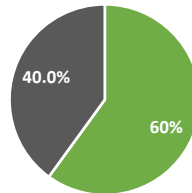

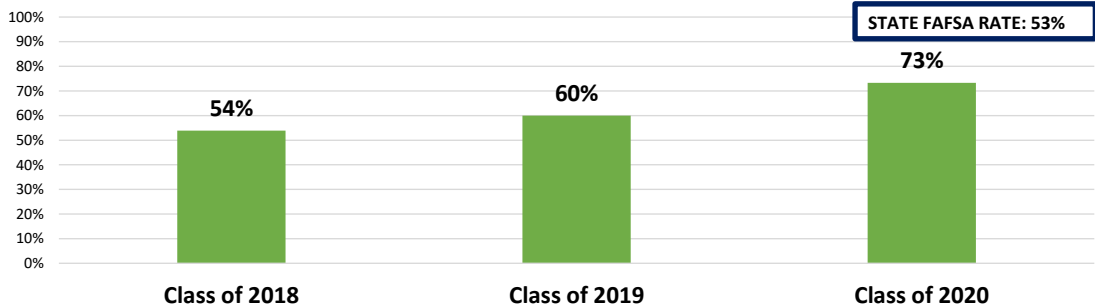
Percent of Students Completing at Least 1
