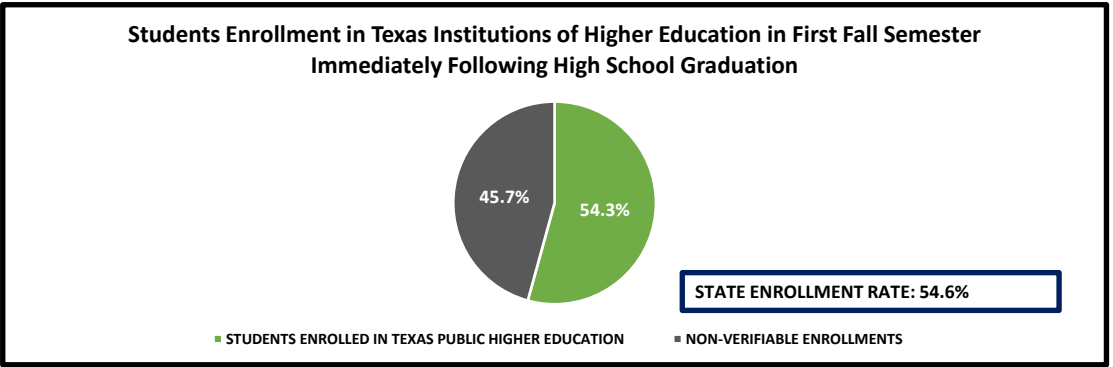

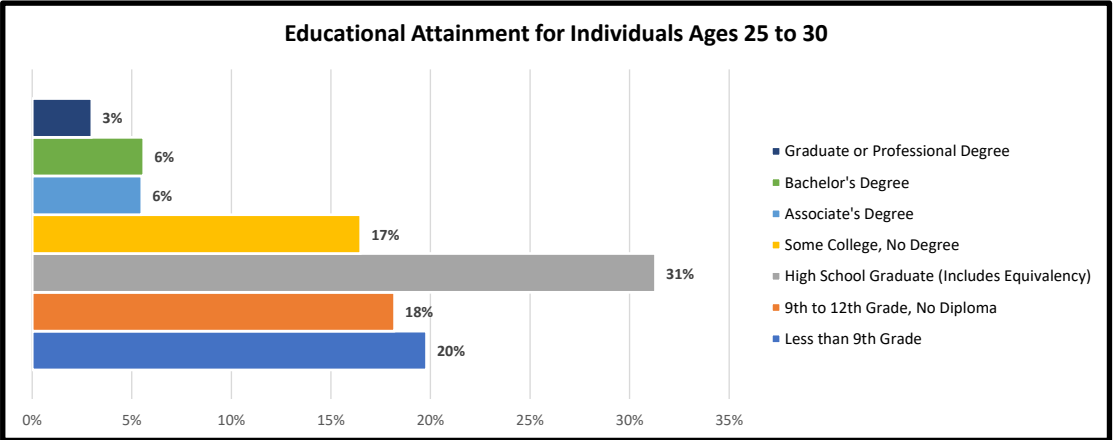

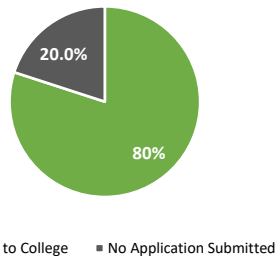

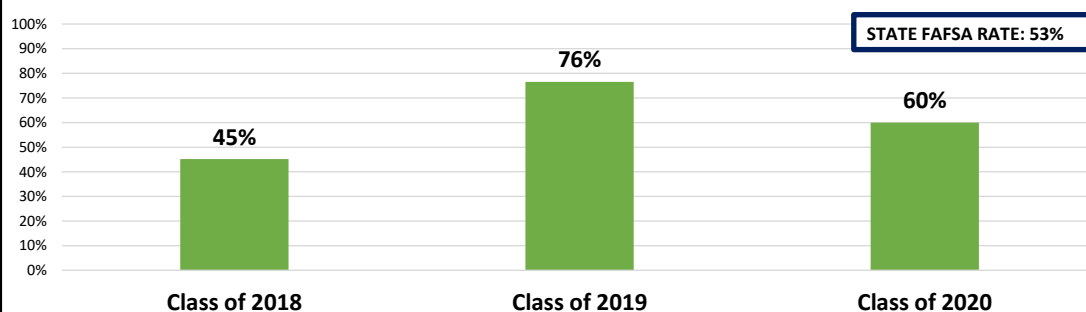
STUDENTS COMPLETING COLLEGE APPLICATIONS - LA PRYOR ISD
